Mikva Challenge works with young people in the city of Chicago to develop the next generation of civic leaders, policy-makers, activists and advocates. Working as a paid intern with Mikva could include:

- Developing your leadership and professional skills
- Critically thinking about issues of importance
- Conducting research and developing policy recommendations
- Working on issues connected to health, after school programs, education, parks, or juvenile justice
- Learning how city government works
- Working in the offices of elected officials
- Using social media to take action on community issues
- Advising elected officials and decision makers on youth issues

Program Details

Program Dates: Program begins on June 29th and ends on August 7th. You will work for 16-20 hours per week, 4 days per week. We will have a 4 hour program orientation the week of June 22nd.

Award: Interns will receive a stipend, lunch, and CTA fare to and from work.

You can apply if: You live in Chicago and will be between the ages of 16-20 on June 30, 2015. (You must be born on or before June 29, 1999!). You can be in high school, college, or out of school.
