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**After Conventions, CPS Students to Give Their Own Take on Politics  
140 Chicago Youth to Speak Out at #PopUpSoapBox This Thursday**

**What:** Pop-Up Soapbox

**Who:** 140 Chicago Teens convened by Mikva Challenge

**Time & Location:** 12:00 pm @ Daley Plaza (50 W. Washington St.) on Thursday, August 4, 2016

**Why:** To insert youth voice into local and national public dialogues on the issues that affect the city

As our nation gears up for the upcoming Presidential Election in November, conversations have been sparked about equality, immigration reform, employment, violence prevention and more; however, the voices of youth have been largely left out. Over one hundred teens from across Chicago, convened by Mikva Challenge, want to change this. To increase youth voice in important conversations, youth will be giving 'pop-up' soapbox speeches in Daley Plaza. A soapbox speech is a 3 minute spontaneous speech, often about a political subject.

"We have our own experiences and it's important we share because no one else has our perspective," shares Uriel B., a 16-year-old CPS student and a member of Mikva's Student Advisory Council.

The youth will be presenting on-the-spot speeches about relevant topics that affect their current lives and futures — including police harassment, teen health, immigration, juvenile justice, education, gender equality, and LGBTQ+ issues. "We are are ready to take our future into our own hands," as voiced by 17-year-old Darcy P., "I don't want my future to be planned by someone else, I'd rather have it planned by myself and my peers."
